Energy Department Releases Updated eGallon Prices

The Energy Department released its most recent pricing data showing the low cost of fueling on electricity. The eGallon, a quick and simple way for consumers to compare the costs of fueling electric vehicles vs. driving on gasoline, rose slightly to \$1.18 from \$1.14 in the latest monthly numbers, but remains far below the \$3.49 cost of a gallon of gasoline.

Easier Blink Charging Check-in:

Until now, when you registered for to charge at a Blink charger, you had to input your zip code. Now all you have to do is waive your card, plug in and press the charge button. One less step.

New Tesla Fast Charger up and running in Fremont:

4-station Tesla Superchargers at the Fremont Plant

County installed chargers in Petaluma, Healdsburg and Cloverdale. After these are up and running, chargers are planned for Guerneville, Doran Park and maybe Sea Ranch.

Note: The City of Santa Rosa charging stations are now pay stations and require a Chargepoint card.
